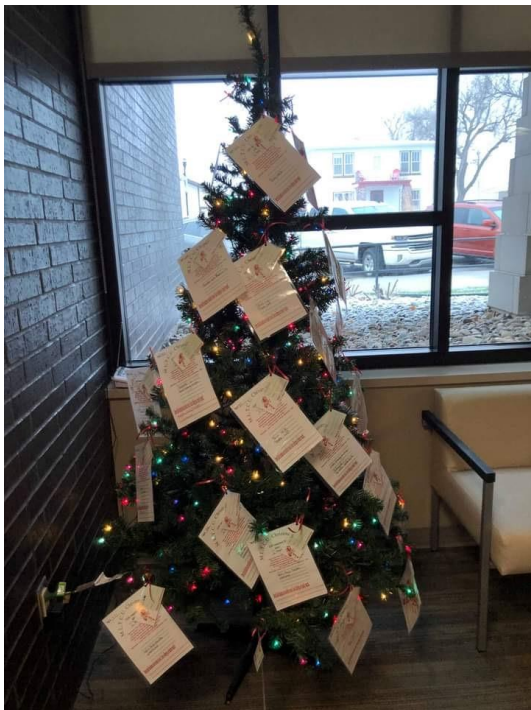


Our 2020 Angel Tree
