

## Our New CT Scanner!



The Radiology Department got a new CT scanner as of June 1st. The Siemens Somatom Go. Up system has advanced software that increases our image quality, while reducing the radiation dose to our patients. Another benefit this machine has is metal artifact removal such as joint replacements, spinal implants, stent grafts, and many more. We upgraded from a 16-slice scanner to a 32-slice scanner which decreases our scan times. In return, it will lessen breath hold times and total scan time. We are now able to provide calcium scoring at Minneola Healthcare as well.
